

**English – a range of English skills explored linked to the following stimuli:**

- *Dream Giver* - a short film.

Pupils will write character / setting description,; their own dream sequences; a fantasy narrative and finally their own newspaper report.

- 'Once In a Lifetime' - a short film.

Pupils will write a job advertisement, diary entry and non-chronological report.

Pupils will also work on their grammar; in particular on being able to identify different word classes.

**Art and Technology**

Oil pastels - We will be exploring a range of effects using oil pastels in order to create a striking Egyptian crown.

We will also be working on a whole school mural project. Pupils will apply decoration using needle and thread and sequins

**Science – Electricity**

- Identify common appliances that run on electricity
- Construct a simple series electrical circuit, identifying and naming its basic parts, including cells, wires, bulbs, switches and buzzers
- Identify whether or not a lamp will light in a simple series circuit.
- Recognise some common conductors and insulators, and associate metals with being good conductors.

**Maths – a range of maths skills, including:**

- Place value  
Roman Numerals, rounding, partitioning, ordering, counting in multiples of 25 and 1000, negative numbers
- Addition and subtraction
- Measurement - length and perimeter

**Buddhism – The Life of Buddha**

*Is it possible for everyone to be happy?*

- Pupils will consider what happiness means to them' Pupils will think about what factors impact on their own and others happiness.
- Pupils will learn about what Buddhists believe about the life of Siddhattha (Buddha)
- Pupils will learn what Buddhists believe about the 8-fold path.
